

## ARMATURE DIAGRAM & MEASUREMENTS

In the second and third tutorial webcasts, Mark will demonstrate how to create an armature, or framework, for sculpting your Lockdown Bobbys.

The measurements and diagram below illustrate an armature Mark uses to create a wee sculpture of Scrumpy, the Cairn Terrier.

You can do one similar – or play about to find one that works for your “Bobby” model!

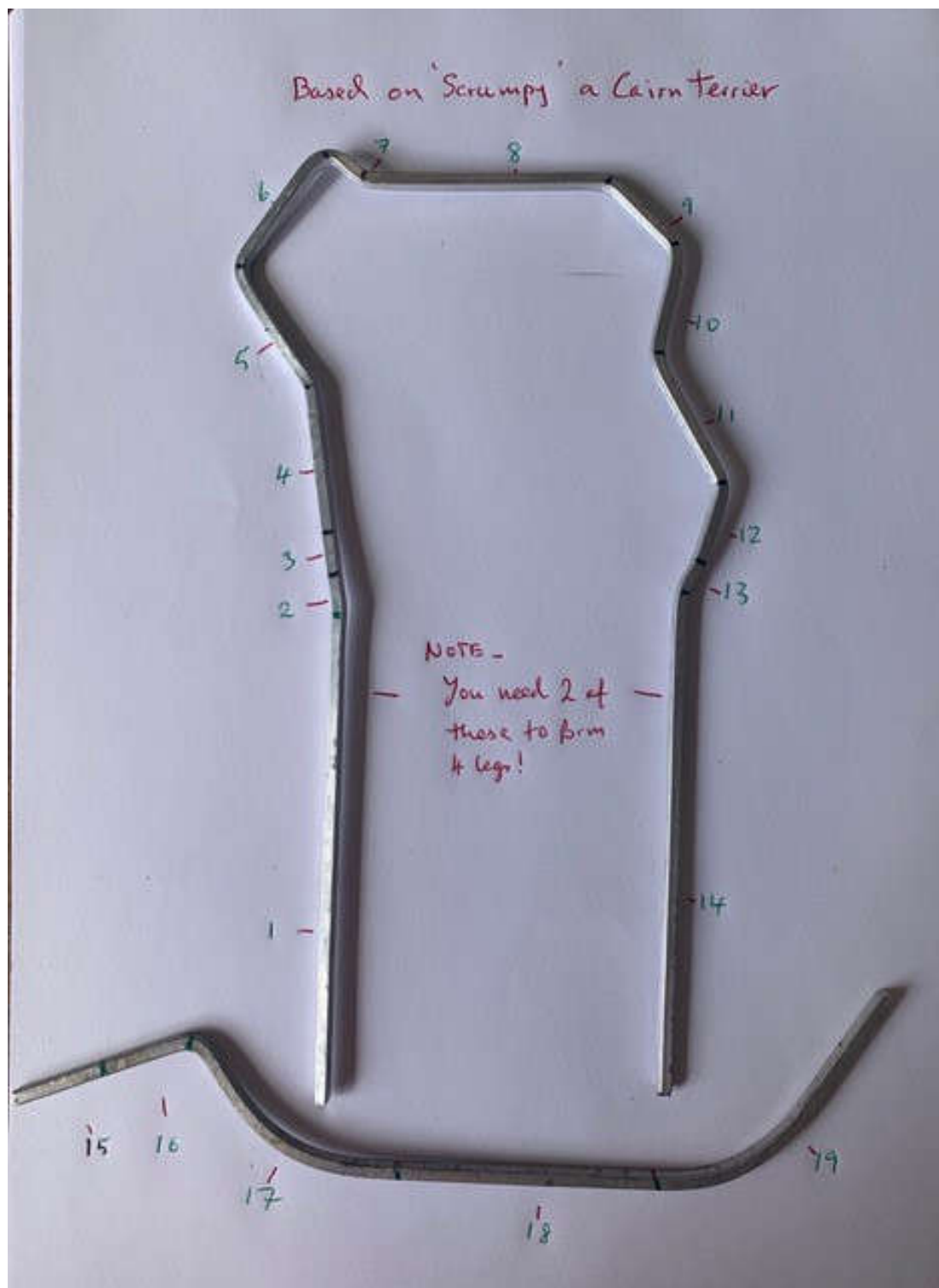
Section on Diagram	Measurement in centimetres
1	11
2	1
3	0.8
4	3.2
5	3.2
6	3.2
7	0.8
8	5.6
9	2
10	2.4
11	3.2
12	1.8
13	0.8
14	11
Total length	50 cm

Section on Diagram	Measurement in centimetres
15	2
16	2
17	5.6
18	5.6
19	6.4
Total length	21.6 cm

Sections 1 to 14 will take shape and form the armature running from a front paw, up the foreleg, along the spine, down the hind leg to back paw. You will need to make two of these, to give your sculpture dog four legs!

Sections 15-19 will form the armature running from the tip of the nose to the tip of the tail.
